



## Members Lounge

The membership at Craigielaw covers a very wide ranging section of the population and we want all members to enjoy the facilities at the club including the Members Lounge. Below are some general guidelines on the use of the Lounge, we would ask all members to be reasonable and considerate on the room usage and if you have any issue with how the room operates or a specific incident please see a member of staff.

## Guidelines

- The Members Lounge is for the exclusive use of all members of Craigielaw Golf Club. All categories have the right to use the lounge.
- Guests – Members are allowed to bring guests & family members into the lounge, we would ask all members to be considerate of other members when bringing guests into the lounge, especially on busy days/times. If you have a number of guests (4 or more) please ask a member of staff if it is possible to use the lounge.
- Young children and babies – Children and babies are welcome in the lounge, again we would ask members to be considerate when taking young children and babies into the lounge so as not to disrupt other members enjoyment of the room.
- Mobile Phones – Mobile phones and tablets are allowed to be used in the lounge to check emails & browse the internet etc. They are not allowed to make phone calls. Please go to the entrance area to use a phone.
- Reserving tables – Members are not allowed to reserve tables in the members lounge. Tables can be reserved in the main lounge and restaurant.
