Friday 18th October 2024

1. Course Update

Course Walk – G. Dalziel said the course walk was very informative and enjoyable. To be repeated in the New Year.

D. Scott said that the mild wet weather had caused some disease on the greens, this had been sprayed for early and would check the disease, there was still growth on the greens so any scarring caused by the disease would grow out.

D. Scott went on to say that the bunker renovation work was now well underway, turf was being cut from a new turf nursery created over the last few years. It was hoped to repair or re do 20 bunkers but this would be dependant on the weather.

17th Hole – D. Scott reported that there had been damage to the apron of the 17th Green. Multiple large deep divots had been taken out of the apron going in the direction back to the 17th Tee. It is hoped this is an isolated case and the damage was repaired. If issues continue then cameras would be placed in the area. New fencing would also be put in at the back of the 17th tee to stop people walking out onto the course from that area.

D. Scott said that the new management software was ready to use but there were links to the clubs payment gateway to be set up before it could go live it was hoped this would be December. G. Dalziel said the system looked simple and easy to use.
